DESPITE the many brilliant "Vocalion" records by H.M. Life Guards' Band already published, we venture to say that nothing finer has yet appeared in our lists than record K-05098, containing the most salient points of "Capriccio Espagnol" by Rimsky-Korsakov. This famous Russian composer, who for many years of his life was a naval officer, eventually became a professor in the Conservatoire of Music at Petrograd, and wrote many compositions, of which the present example and "Scheherezade" are probably the best known. His music is full of colour and stirring rhythm, of which points Lieut. Eldridge has taken the fullest possible advantage when assisting us to produce this magnificent example of military band recording.

It is interesting to note a new record of Philip Braham's "Limehouse Blues," which Andre Charlot included when he took his "Revue of 1924" to U.S.A. This 'Show' has proved an enormous success in the States, and here we have our American cousins' admirable dance version of one of the most popular numbers in the Revue.
